Gage Elementary is in the residential community of San Carlos and serves the students that live in the neighborhood. They have an exciting instructional program that is based on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) and Spanish Immersion. This includes enrichment activities throughout the day and after school. Gage's diverse student population of approximately 480 celebrates these heritages. Also offered at the school are garden and running programs and various family activities to encourage parent and community involvement.

The campus has 18 buildings that total just over 50,000 square feet of facilities that include administration offices, classrooms, library, and multipurpose room. The original five buildings were built in 1963, three additional buildings were built in 1968 and the library building was added in 2003. To accommodate a growing student population, portable classroom buildings have been added over the years.
