










LATEST DRAFT OF SITE PLAN












OPTION 2 PHASING: Middle School On-site

Phase 4:


Demolish (12) portables. Construction of Art, PE Flex, UTK & Kindergarten











































OPTION 2 PHASING: SUMMARY OF CHALLENGES & SITE CONSTRAINTS

- a. Concern for student safety during construction activities
- No Safe Dispersal Area; students and staff will need to exit towards Washington Place which poses a security concern. Code requirement is 3 SF per person and 50' away from all buildings/structures
- c. Need accessible path of travel to all spaces
- d. Inadequate staging area for contractors to store materials
- e. Buildings require large crane to pickup materials from staging area and install onto building structures
- f. Construction directly adjacent to academic spaces will be disruptive with construction noise


- g. Increase in construction timeline
- h. No staff parking
- No student drop off
- j. No middle school outdoor play areas or athletic field
- k. Deliveries for food service and supplies within student areas poses a safety concern
- g. No lunch shelter or Gecko Garden





WHAT WE HEARD FROM 08/28 MEETING

- Concerns about moving Middle School to a different location
- Explore other alternatives that would keep Middle School students on campus (on-site Interim Housing)
- District to continue communicating progress with parents and community
- Concerns about moving Middle School to Fremont/Ballard Center site; explore moving to an existing school campus
