Correia Middle School serves the communities of Point Loma, Ocean Beach and Old Town with approximately 830 students for the seventh and eighth grades. They also receive students from the district through the School Choice Program and Voluntary Enrollment Exchange Program. As part of the Point Loma Cluster Council, Correia is committed to the smooth matriculation between campuses with a common vision of the other participating schools in the community of Point Loma.

Correia's campus is situated on a 35-acre space and consists of 11 permanent buildings that were built in 1958, along with 12 portable buildings. These facilities are for classrooms, administration offices, an auditorium, a cafeteria with kitchen, a physical education building with locker rooms and a library/media center that was built in 2004. The remaining areas of the campus are an asphalt court area, DG play field, turf play field and parking lots.

This project consists of design and construction of a retaining wall with ornamental block facade along Famosa Boulevard and Valeta Street. The wall was built to prevent storm run-off by retaining the soil. This project also includes irrigation, landscaping and new fencing above the new retaining wall.



The Correia Middle School Athletic Facilities Project includes upgrades to the existing 363,000-square-foot sports field in an effort to improve physical education, athletic facilities and turf fields. This project also includes improvements that are needed to comply with the American's with Disabilities Act (ADA). The proposed project includes the following components:

- Four multi-use fields
- · A new softball field
- Field lighting
- A new concession/restroom building
- Reconstruction of basketball/ tennis courts




Proposed Site Plan





A Solar Photovoltaic System installation will take place at SCPA. The system for this campus has solar panels that are mounted on tilt elevated canopies at the parking lot and within campus. These canopies provide shade structures and under-mount LED lighting for parking lots. This system will create an energy-efficient and renewable power source. It will deliver a clean energy supply during both the academic year and school vacations.

All elements of installation will include, but not limited to:

- Solar PV modules
- Inverters
- All electrical connectors, cabling and components necessary for a complete solar system
- All mounting systems
- Permanent fencing, gates and hardware for all ground mounted equipment
