E.B. Scripps ES officially opened their doors in 2001. Then in 2008, they moved to their current campus in the Scripps Ranch area of San Diego. The school services the residents of this thriving community. With a diverse school population of approximately 750, they have grown into an award winning school. In 2016, E.B. Scripps was one of five schools in the San Diego Unified School District to be awarded a California Gold Ribbon School based on their “exceptional gains in implementing the academic content and performance standards.”

The campus facilities consist of 8 permanent buildings for classrooms, administration offices, library, multi-purpose and food services; and 9 portable classroom buildings. The remaining part of the campus is made up of a playground area and parking lot.

A Solar Photovoltaic System will be installed at EB Scripps Elementary School. The proposed system for this campus will have solar panels that are mounted on tilt elevated canopies within the existing parking lot. These canopies will provide shade structures and under-mount LED lighting for parking lots. This system will create an energy-efficient and renewable power source. It will deliver a clean energy supply during both the academic year and school vacations.

All elements of installation will include, but not limited to:

- Solar PV modules
- Inverters
- All electrical connectors, cabling and components necessary for a complete solar system
- All mounting systems
