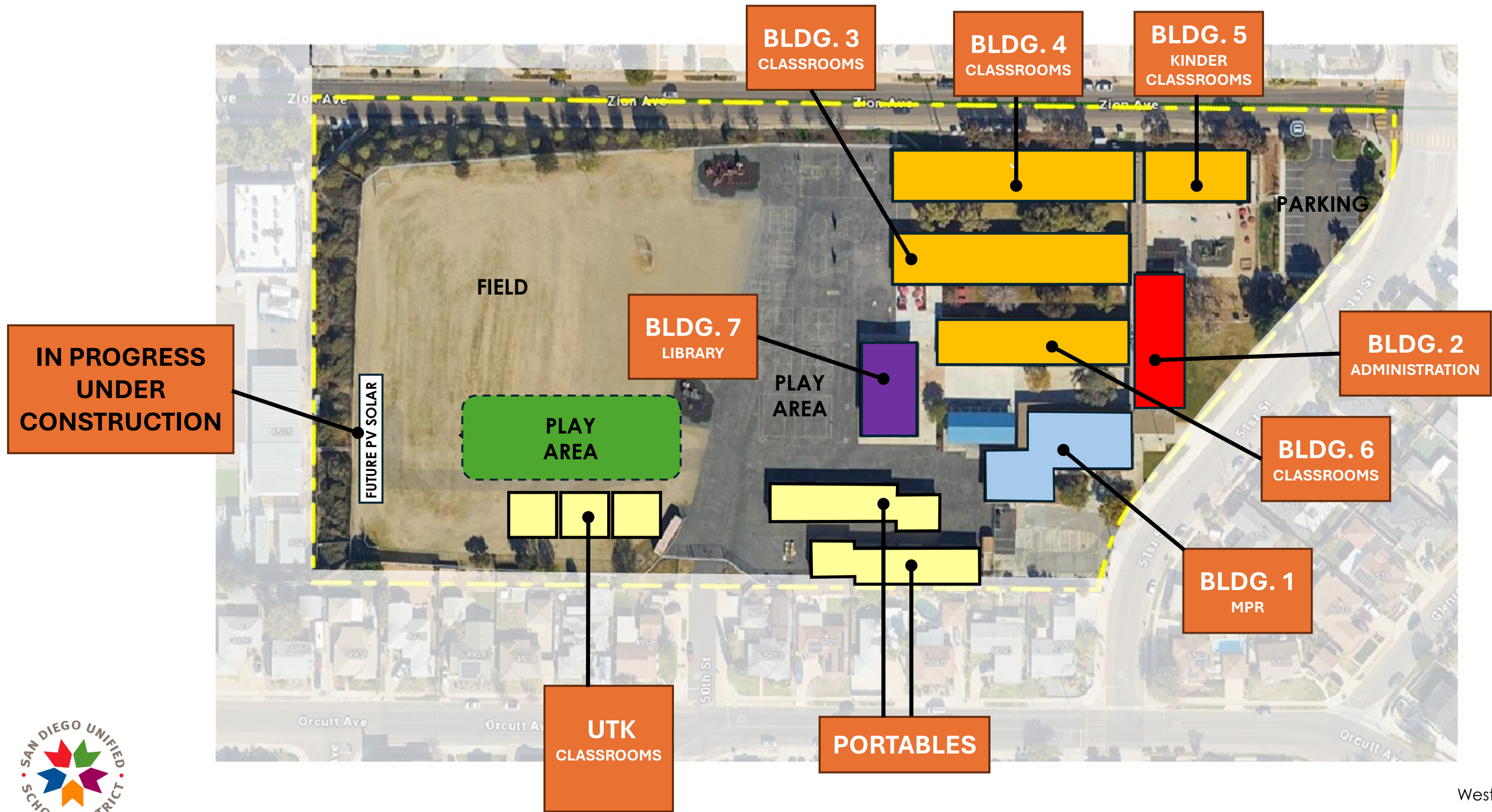
- OPTIMIZE SINGLE SECURED ENTRY INFRASTRUCTURE

  - PROVIDE CONFERENCE ROOM AND STAFF LOUNGE TO ACCOMMODATE GROUP MEETINGS







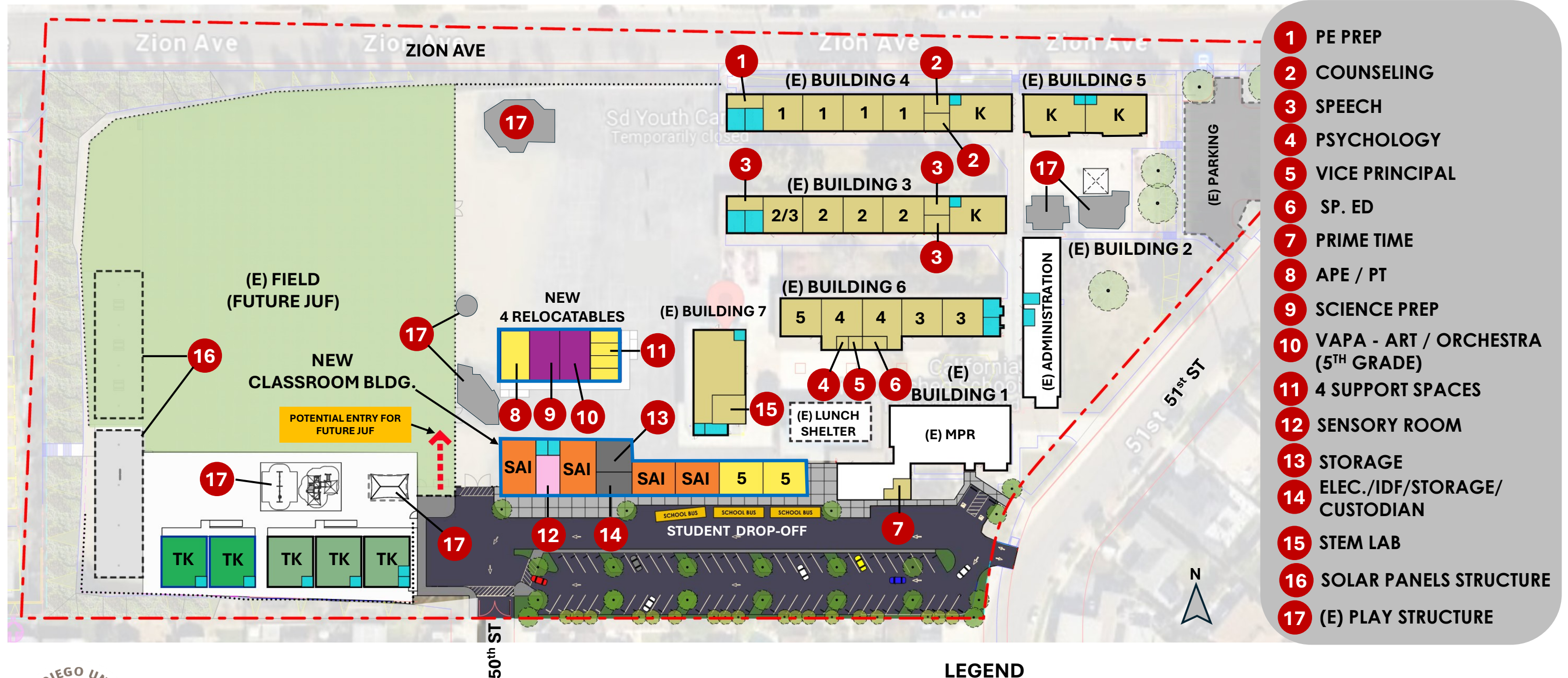

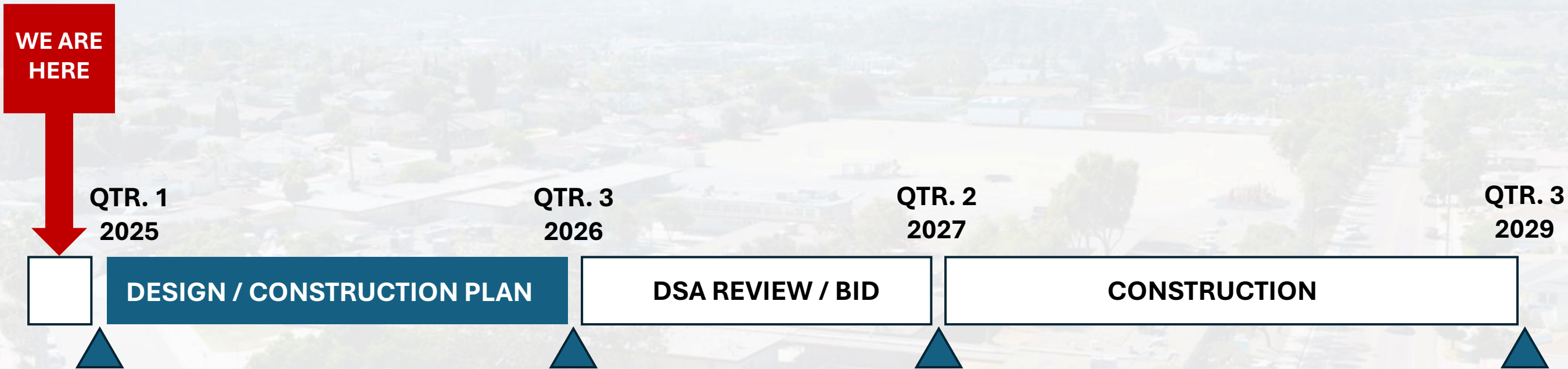
# CONCEPT SITE PLAN

- Open for use: Quarter 3 2029 (after WHOLE SITE MODERNIZATION)





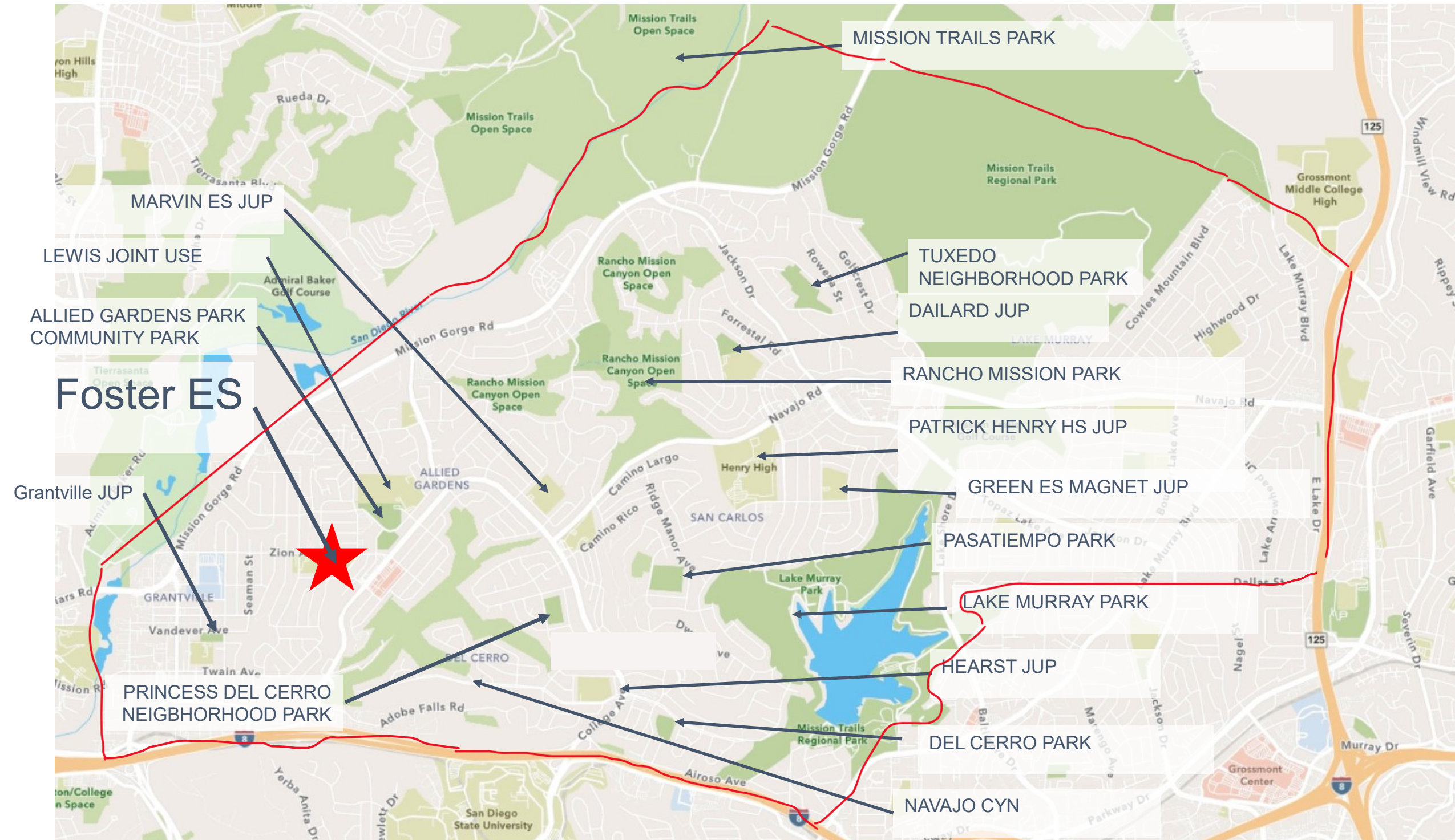

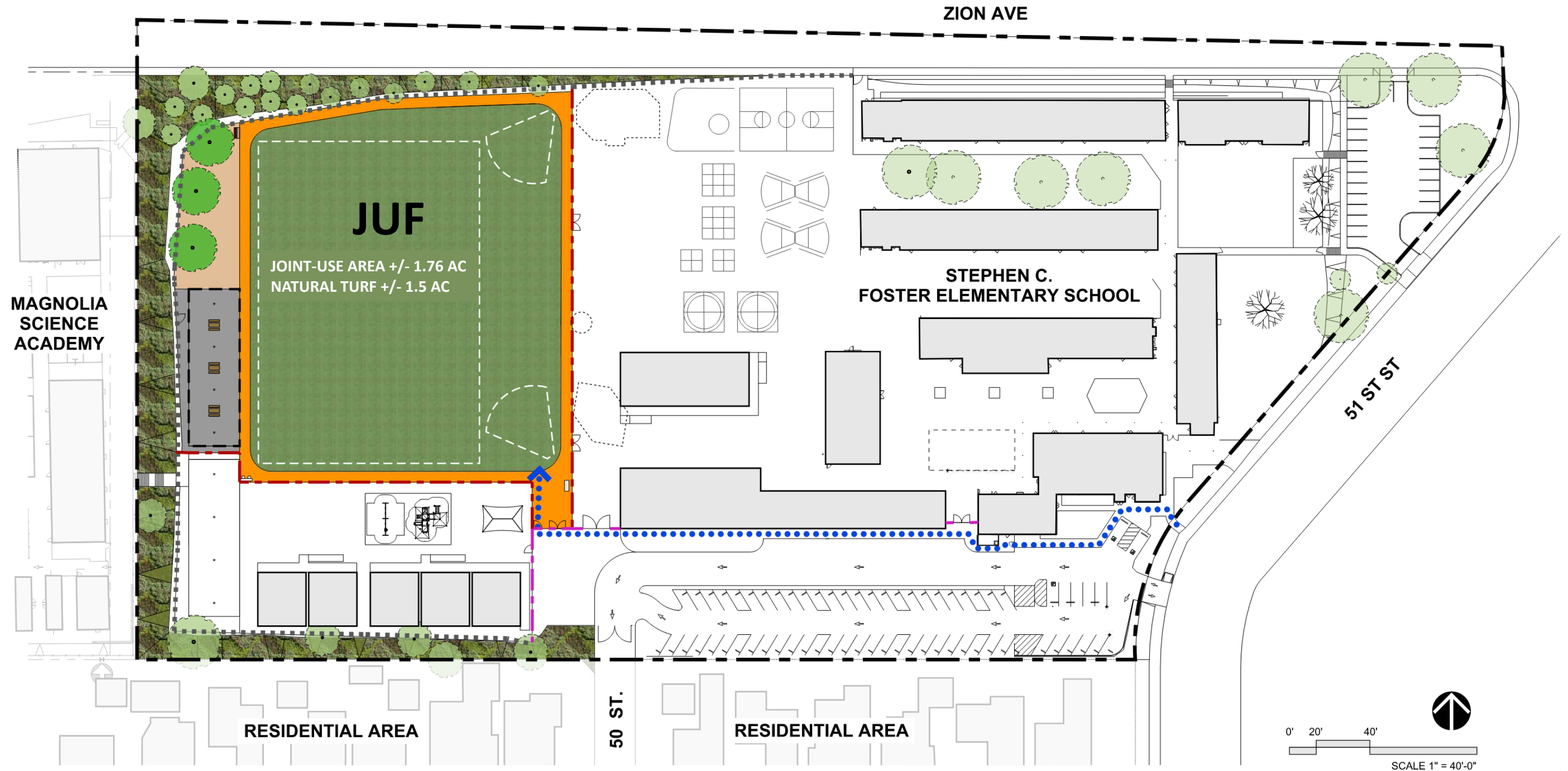
