- improve student learning and achievement
- improve accountability

Site-Specific Bond Project List

The following needs were identified through a comprehensive planning process, which included input from school site representatives to cluster meetings, district departments and other assessment measures.

The language below will be included in the bond resolution:

Project Improvements to Support Student Learning and Instruction

- **Provide 21st century technology upgrades, including audiovisual projection capabilities for all students**
- **Provide a wireless network (WIFI)**

School Improvements to Support Student Health, Safety and Security

- **Replace obsolete fire alarm and emergency communications system**
- **Renovate food service area, including cafeteria, to increase service efficiency and provide healthier food choices**
- **Provide food kiosks and additional covered exterior dining areas**
- **Install security lighting, as well as increase vandalism and intrusion safeguards, including modifications to fencing and gates, to secure site**
- **Remove or minimize risks of any potentially hazardous material throughout the facility**
- **Improve student drop-off and pick-up area**

Projects to Improve School Accessibility, Code Compliance Upgrades

- **Renovate existing restrooms**
- **Renovate locker rooms and create additional storage space from underutilized square footage**
- **Renovate gym, including new bleachers, to meet accessibility regulations**
- **Improve accessibility to all classrooms, labs, restrooms, and other school facilities to comply with accessibility regulations, including ADA Titles I & II**
- **Install grease trap and three-compartment sink in kitchen**
- **Renovate/replace old stadium bleachers, including press box, storage, and accessible concessions**
- **Upgrade fields for safe use and compliance with accessibility regulations**
- **Provide new accessible restrooms for stadium and field area**
- **Provide accessible weight room/fitness space**

Major Building Systems Repair/Replacement

- **Repair/replace old and deteriorating plumbing and sewer lines as needed**
- **Repair site sidewalks, ramps, and stairs where needed**
- **Repair/upgrade building interiors, exteriors, finishes and fixtures as needed**
- **Repair/replace outdated heating and air-conditioning systems where needed**
- **Replace aging wiring and upgrade electrical systems, including the addition of needed data connections**
- **Repair/replace/upgrade performance spaces**



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Building Systems Repair and Replacement

- Repair deteriorated interior and exterior finishes and fixtures
- Repair or replace aging, leaky roofs
- Repair or replace cracked and broken concrete sidewalks, hardscape, and exterior infrastructure
- Repair or upgrade outdated electrical systems, aging wiring and electrical panels
- Repair, replace plumbing and deteriorated sewer systems
- Repair, replace worn or damaged doors and windows
- Replace synthetic turf at football field
- Replacement of old light fixtures and fluorescent light ballasts
- Upgrade damaged, deteriorated asphalt parking lots and playground surfaces

School Improvements to Support Student Learning and Instruction

- Provide up-to-date classroom and instructional technology required for 21st century student learning and teaching
- Upgrade wired and wireless infrastructure and equipment to support technology systems and leverage federal and state matching funds for school technology programs

College Career and Technical Education Facility Improvements

- Construct college, career and technical education facilities

School Improvements to Support Student Health, Safety and Security

- Provide school site security improvements, including increased lighting, fencing, and vandalism and intrusion safeguards
- Replace obsolete fire alarms and update emergency communications systems

Improve School Accessibility and Code Compliance Upgrades

- Improve accessibility for disabled persons and comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Title 24
- Modernize and renovate physical education facilities, playgrounds and fields to comply with Title IX gender equity requirements

Quality Neighborhood Schools

- Remove or replace old and inadequate buildings with new facilities
- Improve physical education, athletic facilities and turf fields
