Linda Vista Elementary School is now known as Linda Vista STEAM Magnet School. STEAM represents Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics learning. The approximately 377 student population is made up of 75% English learners. They offer two programs, either academic or Spanish bi-literacy academic. These programs are provided with a strong parent involvement and after school programs with college tutors.

Built during in the early 1940s, during the rapid growth of the wartime effort, the vintage architecture is the pride of the Linda Vista Community. The facilities comprise of 62,133 square feet of space that includes administration offices, classrooms, a multipurpose room with food service and a library. There are five permanent buildings and five portable classrooms.
