McKinley ES is in the historic community of North Park. The 580 students are taught through an academic curriculum that is based on the International Baccalaureate (IB) Primary Years program which enriches their school day in all activities. The global-view approach helps foster critical thinking and positive, compassionate learners that prepares the students to become internationally minded citizens.

Joint Use Field

The campus is a mixture of structures and updated buildings that were added throughout the years. The original 1925 two school buildings were replaced in 1975 by a large building servicing as administration offices, classrooms and library. A multi-purpose food services and auditorium building was constructed in 1945. During the Prop MM initiative, there were 2 two-story classroom loft-style buildings erected. The remaining campus is comprised of nine portable classrooms, a covered lunch court and a school wide garden with murals titled "Gardens Around the World." The entire school assists in maintaining and adding to the garden, which is used regularly for classroom activities. In 2017, the decomposed granite play ground was replaced with a natural turf joint use play field to be used as a community park during non-school hours.
