

Mission Bay High School is located on Grand Avenue, a main thoroughfare that leads into the community of Pacific Beach. The high school is one of two International Baccalaureate high schools in the district. Barnard Elementary Magnet School, which relocated from Point Loma to what was Bayview Terrace Elementary, is across the street.

The school was constructed using wood framing and masonry in 1953. It sits on approximately 36-acres consisting of 22 permanent buildings including a gymnasium and newly remodeled weight room, a library with two new computer labs, a small theater, and a 790-seat auditorium. Twenty-seven portables were added at different times to accommodate increased student population. The site is bordered by residential housing, a campground/marina and Rose Creek, an urban stream that drains into Mission Bay.

Football Stadium/Facilities, Softball Stadium & Track and Field Upgrades

The existing 4.83-acre football stadium now features new artificial turf and all-weather track and a new softball field. In addition, 8,369-square-feet of athletic facility upgrades, compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act, were added.

The new state-of-the-art football stadium features:

- 1,600 capacity bleachers on home side and 800 on visitors' side
- Press box with elevator
- New ticket booth, restrooms, and concession stand, and entrance gates for home and visitors'
- New lighting, sound system, scoreboard, and goalposts
- Sand pit for long jump/triple jump/track for high jump and pole vault

The new softball field features:

- Existing field relocated and new synthetic turf field installed
- New concession stand and announcer's booth
- New dugouts, scoreboard, backstop, and perimeter fencing
- · Adjacent shot-put and discus area

Additionally, new bleachers, a concession stand, and announcer's booth were added to the baseball field.



The Whole Site Modernization project will improve the learning environment, health, safety and security of the students as well as upgrade accessibility where needed to comply with accessibility regulations. This effort is to implement the improvements which include but is not limited to the following:

Main Campus:

- Demolish 16 portable classrooms and 1 relocatable restroom buildings due to decreased enrollment and provide 4 new relocatable classroom and 1 relocatable restroom buildings
- Remodel administration office and campus entry
- Provide new campus entry on Lee Street
- Repair/restore building interior/exterior finishes & fixtures as needed
- Modernize existing CTE classrooms
- Improve accessibility throughout campus

- New student drop off
- Install new heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems in classrooms and other spaces
- Upgrade old plumbing and sewer systems
- Upgrade fire alarms and emergency communications systems
- Install security lighting
- Install security fencing








