Site-Specific Bond Project List

The following needs were identified through a comprehensive planning process, which included input from school site representatives to cluster meetings, district departments and other assessment measures.

The language below will be included in the bond resolution:

Project Improvements to Support Student Learning and Instruction

- **Retrofit/build spaces to provide new and updated career technical learning environments for the Child Development and Family Services Program, the Auto Ready Program, the Culinary Arts Program and other educational spaces to support program needs**
- **Provide 21st century technology upgrades, including audiovisual projection capabilities for all students**
- **Provide a wireless network (WIFI)**

School Improvements to Support Student Health, Safety and Security

- **Replace obsolete fire alarm and site emergency communications system**
- **Renovate food service area, including cafeteria, and add food kiosks to increase service efficiency and provide healthier food choices**
- **Install security lighting, as well as increase vandalism and intrusion safeguards, including modifications and additions to fencing and gates**
- **Remove or minimize risks of any potentially hazardous material**
- **Make structural repairs to buildings to meet current seismic standards**
- **Make modifications for slope stabilization on site**

Projects to Improve School Accessibility, Code Compliance Upgrades

- **Renovate existing restrooms**
- **Renovate/reconfigure locker rooms to provide compliant accessibility**
- **Renovate gym, including new bleachers, to meet accessibility regulations**
- **Improve accessibility to all classrooms, labs, restrooms, and other school facilities to comply with accessibility regulations including ADA Titles I & II**
- **Install grease trap and three-compartment sink in kitchen**
- **Renovate/reconfigure stadium bleachers, including press box**
- **Upgrade fields and track for safe use and compliance with accessibility regulations**
- **Build new two-story classroom building to replace old portable classrooms**
- **Provide new accessible restrooms for stadium and include concessions and storage**
- **Develop separate visitor entrance with gates and ticket booth**
- **Provide accessible weight room/fitness space**

Major Building Systems Repair/Replacement

- **Repair/replace plumbing and electrical systems**
- **Repair/upgrade building interiors, exteriors, finishes and fixtures**
- **Repair/replace outdated heating and air-conditioning systems where needed**
- **Replace aging wiring and upgrade electrical as needed**
- **Repair/replace/upgrade performance spaces**



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Building Systems Repair and Replacement

- Repair deteriorated interior and exterior finishes and fixtures
- Repair or replace deteriorated roofs
- Door, window, hardware repairs or replacement
- Upgrade old/deteriorated electrical systems, wiring and panels
- Repair or replace security cameras
- Repair, replace plumbing and deteriorated sewer systems
- Replace or repair concrete sidewalks and other exterior infrastructure in poor condition
- Replace synthetic turf at football field
- Improve amphitheater and replace audio system
- Replace vinyl flooring and tile
- Replacement of old light fixtures and fluorescent light ballasts
- Resurfacing and grading of decomposed granite playgrounds and fields
- Sand and refinish wood stage, gym and classroom floors
- Upgrade damaged, deteriorated asphalt parking lots and playground surfaces

School Improvements to Support Student Learning and Instruction

- Provide up-to-date classroom and instructional technology required for 21st century student learning and teaching
- Upgrade wired and wireless infrastructure and equipment to support technology systems and leverage federal and state matching funds for school technology programs

College, Career and Technical Education Facility Improvements

- Construct college, career and technical education facilities

School Improvements to Support Student Health, Safety and Security

- Provide school site security improvements, including increased lighting, fencing, and vandalism and intrusion safeguards
- Upgrade and expand student food service areas and kitchens
- Replace obsolete fire alarms and update emergency communications systems

Improve School Accessibility and Code Compliance Upgrades

- Improve accessibility for disabled persons and comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Title 24
- Modernize and renovate physical education facilities, playgrounds and fields to comply with Title IX gender equity requirements

Quality Neighborhood Schools

- Develop a pedestrian path-of-travel connecting the Fulton and Morse campuses
- Construct new visual and performing arts theater
- Improve physical education, athletic facilities, soccer field and turf fields
- Construct new gymnasium
