This campus is nestled in the residential community of northern Pacific Beach. The school environment is community related with all students, teachers, staff and parents involved in school activities. The average student population is 390 from grades kindergarten through fifth. Students are taught a unique and challenging curriculum with programs that enhance their learning experience. There is an interactive maker space and science lab available for all grades, Arts On Track Program, YMCA PE, and Positive Behavior Intervention, just to name a few.

The original two campus buildings were built in 1930 and 1938 with an additional five buildings added from 1940-1957. The 1930 buildings were replaced in 1976 by one building, as well as the five buildings constructed for the Los Altos Child Development Center on site. There were also three portable buildings added due to increased student population. The total square footage of facilities is now 41,203. These buildings are for administration offices, classrooms, library/media, and a multipurpose room with food services.

This Joint Use Agreement (JUA) project with the City of San Diego involves the construction of a full amenities park by the City on the schools existing Decomposed Granite (DG) Field. A detailed scope of work is developed using input from the school community and facilities condition assessments.
