Rolando Park Elementary School serves the college area community of Rolando. The diverse student population reflects the residential community it resides in. Approximately 65 percent of the 210 (average attendance) students are English learners being taught through a comprehensive curriculum. The staff, students and parents are proud of their school community with active involvement.

The campus consists of 37,531 square feet of learning space that includes classroom buildings, administration offices, multipurpose room, library, media center, lunch court and portable classroom buildings. The original 9 buildings were built in 1952. Three more buildings were added in 1958. In 2006, a library, media building and covered lunch court were built for students.




## Rolando Park Elementary School Joint Use Field With City of San Diego
