



School and Park Improvements Coming to University City!

Construction is starting on a multi-phase project that will build a joint-use aquatic center at Standley Middle School and provide a major modernization of Spreckels Elementary School.

At Standley Middle School, joint-use improvements include a new pool, an outdoor pavilion for school and community gatherings and a walking and running path.

The Whole Site Modernization of Spreckels Elementary School includes a new two-story classroom building and a new joint-use grass playfield that replaces the decomposed granite field.

Once these projects near completion, a modernization of Standley Middle School will begin.

This project is funded by San Diego Unified's Proposition Z and Measure YY, as well as a contribution from the City of San Diego.

- ➡ Joint-use improvements at Standley Middle School include a pool amenities building housing outdoor showers, changing rooms, restrooms, and support spaces.
- ➡ Renovations to Spreckels Elementary School include construction of a new student pick-up/drop-off area and additional off-street parking, creation of a secure and controlled visitor entry point, and major upgrades to the existing classroom, multi-purpose, and administration buildings.
- ➡ The new field at Spreckels Elementary includes a walking/running path and new hard court play areas.

Description:

The Standley Middle School joint-use improvements project is being planned in conjunction with the Spreckels Elementary whole site modernization.

The joint-use improvements project at Standley Middle School includes a new aquatic center, outdoor pavilion, and walking/running path.

The new aquatic center includes an outdoor pool (35M x 25yd) and pool amenities building, which provides outdoor showers, changing rooms, restrooms, storage and equipment rooms, and an office.

The outdoor pavilion will be a school and community gathering space integrated into the joint-use field. The decomposed granite walking track provides a loop around the perimeter of the joint-use field and adjacent Standley Community Park.

Existing parking at Standley Middle School will also be included for joint-use.
