Site-Specific Bond Project List

The following needs were identified through a comprehensive planning process, which included input from school site representatives to cluster meetings, district departments and other assessment measures.

The language below will be included in the bond resolution:

Project Improvements to Support Student Learning and Instruction

- Retrofit/build spaces to provide new and updated career technical learning environments for the Sustainable Technologies Program and other supporting educational spaces
- Provide 21st century technology upgrades, including audiovisual projection capabilities for all students
- Install a wireless network (WIFI)

School Improvements to Support Student Health, Safety and Security

- Provide emergency communications system
- Install new heating, ventilation, and cooling systems in educational spaces
- Renovate food service area, including cafeteria and additional exterior dining areas, to increase service efficiency and provide healthier food choices and eating environments
- Install security lighting, as well as increase vandalism and intrusion safeguards, including modifications to fencing, to secure site
- Improve vehicular and pedestrian circulation and parking conditions
- · Address acoustical needs due to proximity to freeway

Projects to Improve School Accessibility, Code Compliance Upgrades

- Renovate existing restrooms and locker rooms
- · Renovate gym, including new bleachers, to meet accessibility regulations
- Improve accessibility to all classrooms, labs, restrooms, and other school facilities to comply with accessibility regulations, including ADA Titles I & II
- Renovate/reconfigure stadium home team bleachers and provide new visitor bleachers
- Upgrade fields as required by wear for safe use and compliance with accessibility regulations
- · Renovate restrooms for stadium to meet accessibility regulations

Major Building Systems Repair/Replacement

- Repair/replace damaged plumbing fixtures and sewer systems as needed
- Repair site sidewalks, ramps, and stairs where required
- Repair/upgrade building interiors, exteriors, finishes and fixtures as needed
- Replace aging wiring and upgrade electrical and low voltage systems as needed
- Repair/replace/upgrade performance spaces

Building Systems Repair and Replacement

- Correct interior and exterior deficiencies including finishes and fixtures
- Upgrade old/deteriorated electrical systems, wiring and panels
- Repair or replace cracked and broken concrete sidewalks, hardscape, and exterior infrastructure
- Repair or replace doors and windows
- Repair, replace plumbing and deteriorated sewer systems
- Repair or replace roof systems
- Replace synthetic turf at football field
- Replacement of old light fixtures and fluorescent light ballasts
- Upgrade damaged, deteriorated asphalt parking lots and playground surfaces

School Improvements to Support Student Learning and Instruction

- Provide up-to-date classroom and instructional technology required for 21st century student learning and teaching
- Upgrade wired and wireless infrastructure and equipment to support technology systems and leverage federal and state matching funds for school technology programs

College, Career and Technical Education Facility Improvements

Construct college, career and technical education facilities

School Improvements to Support Student Health, Safety and Security

- Provide school site security improvements, including increased lighting, fencing, and vandalism and intrusion safeguards
- Replace obsolete fire alarms and update emergency communications systems

Improve School Accessibility and Code Compliance Upgrades

- Improve accessibility for disabled persons and comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Title 24
- Modernize and renovate physical education facilities, playgrounds and fields to comply with Title IX gender equity requirements

Quality Neighborhood Schools

- Remove or replace old and inadequate buildings with new facilities
- Improve physical education, athletic facilities and turf fields
