I'm the PSA specialist assigned to this project.

I'm the day-to-day person for this project.

Director George Harris will be joining us in the meeting.

Is the project labor coordinator and you normally we normally only involve director Harris when there's an interpretation issue, some sort of higher ECHELON issue.

Within the PSA.

It's usually when we ask him for his input, also on the call. Today is my colleagues from the PSA coordination team. They'll be helping me to run the meeting today. Today's meeting is a required meeting, according to section 8.1 and 16.1 of the PSA. Some of the intended goals or purposes.

Is the opportunity for the unions and the contractors to.

Come together and discuss work.

Work, work, assignment and manpower needs.

It's also intended the meetings intended to help resolve any kind of issues that might arise.

We we have all the parties here.

We can talk about it right here.

We ask that you put your, that everyone put their contact information in the chat.

The organization you're with.

As well as when you have questions or comments, if you'll comment in the chat. That that allows everyone to see your question that memorialize your question or your response.

This meeting will be recorded.

And uploaded to the cloud when it becomes your turn to when you want to add something to the meeting or speak, we ask that you raise your hand and unmute yourself again. This meeting's going to be recorded.

According to the PSA 2.62 point 4, the PSA, all contractors must submit a signed letter of assent and a work assignment before they can start site work. Non union contractors must have their core employees referred back to the project before they can commence site work.

A referral is where the the employee or the core employee.

Employee will interact with the Union to establish trust fund.

Establish a trust fund and that sort of thing and be referred back to the project.

3.5 of the PSA says there's a local higher goal.

That goal is that 100% of the workforce lives somewhere in the county of San Diego, 70% live in the school district, ZIP code and 35% live in the 11 targeted ZIP code. Codes the way the contractors help us effectuate that hiring goal is that your employees live somewhere in the county of San Diego.

And then when you, if you're, if you have.

A. When you make a request for dispatch that not only do you outline whether or not you need a journeyman or an apprentice, the skill set that you need out of out of that member, but we ask that you.

Ask for someone who lives in the school. Zip code that you're working at.

That's how you.

To help us meet our local higher goal.

Non union contractors. If you have a work assignment that requires more than one worker at a time, or the operation of more than one piece of equipment at the same time, you're likely to have a composite crew on your composite crew.

A contractor can have up to three of his core employees.

Employees Core employee is defined as someone who has been on your payroll. 30 of the last 180 days they possess the skill set or certification of the work being performed, and they live somewhere in the county again, with this composite crew. If you had a composite crew of six positions.

1/3 and five would belong to the contractors.

Where 246 and beyond would be dispatched from the Union hall.

Again, I call them positions because they belong to the contractor, those positions. Another aspect of the PSA is that a timely referral it, meaning that you have your your core employees referred or request for dispatch at least 48 hours less weekends and holidays before the commencement of of site before you.

We need them out on site.

That's a timely referral. I'd like to remind everyone that neither the contractors nor their employees are required to join a Union to perform under the PSA.

They simply have to follow the guidelines and rules of not only the PSA but the the schedule A or master labor agreement they're performing under for the duration of that singular contract has no bearing on what you've done in the past or what you'll do in.

We'll focus on that singular contract.

The prevailing wage that are applicable for this project listed on the DIR website based on the first ever first date the project was advertised for bid. So all the applicable wages are found on that wage determination. Because this is a private agreement, the prevailing wages that you're paying.

Your workers will be separated.

You'll what I mean by that is you pay the base rate on the check where the fringe benefit component is sent to the applicable Union trust fund at a later date. With that before I turn it over to next Gen. to start the meeting, director Harris is there. Anything you'd like to add today?

Are both scheduled to commence as early as next week 421 and proceed through September of of this year of 2025.

The project consists of the installation of a lithium ion battery, energy storage system, infrastructure for edse or electrical vehicle supply equipment and all associated electrical distribution, concrete work, sidewalk ADA modifications, chain link fencing and gates.

Asphalt patch back in pavement markings, NextGen will not be perform self performing any work with exception to general site cleanup and labor.

Assigning laborers local 89.

Again, project will commence as soon as 4/21 next week with standard operating hours Monday through Friday 6:30 to 3:30.
