Let's take a look so purpose of today's meeting is it's mandatory section 8.5 of the PSA.

Go for today's is that we're going to be going over all the work assignments and at the end of this meeting, those work assignments will be final.

We're going to go over project scope, schedule and work rules as well.

Once again, those work assignments.

So after this meeting, there's only two ways that can be changed.

One is at the disputing parties can come to an agreement, and if they cannot, they'll go before an arbitrator who will decide that for them. Let's see.

Contractors. So contractors who are not signature.

To a union and if you will be using more than one manpower you are going to have to utilize the Union hiring halls.

So you're allowed to use of the three coworkers on the project.

They all have to be registered with the Union Hall of the Craft, so I'll give you an example.

Quick example, it says needed a crew size of six or more positions 1/3 and five would be your coworkers.

Positions 24 and six would be registered.

Sorry, would be union dispatch from the Union hall.

Any manpower beyond six has to be dispatched from the Union.

Please make sure to register all your coworkers with the Union Hall of the craft, even

if they're performing.

You have a coworker's performing multiple trades and make sure to register them with each of those. Those union halls that is going to be about it. So from here I'm going to pass it on to John. John's going to give an overall just project. The summary of it and then we're going to get into the list of subcontractors. And when you hear your name called, if you're a sub, call your name. Raise your hand and then you could, uh, give the ability to unmute your microphone and then go ahead and introduce yourself and then go over your pre job form. Just let let us know your scope of work that you're performing and who you're assigning your work to at Union, and that should be about it. Good John. And wanna start off with the scope of work that the overall contract scope.
