On behalf of the San Diego Unified School District, Soltek Pacific Construction is requesting bids from qualified subcontractors (licensed contractor with A or B Classification(s) or C Specialty license for scope noted within the Bid Packages) for:

Barnard Elementary School at Bayview Terrace Phase II WSM CC22-0801-23-A1-G1 (GMP No. 1) (Lease-Leaseback)

3. Project Estimate: is between \$1,500,000 and \$2,000,000
4. Schedule: The anticipated schedule for GMP 1 is May 2023 through August 2023
5. Project Description: The project consists of the installation of interim housing relocatable classrooms, demolition of existing portables and play structures, fire hydrant installation, and restroom renovations.

The successful subcontractors will be required to execute a PSA Letter of Assent (LOA), whereby subcontractors agree to conform to all terms and conditions set forth in the PSA.

BIDDING DOCUMENTS: Each bid shall be in accordance with all terms, conditions, plans, specifications and any other documents that comprise the bid documents. The DSA approved plans and specifications, appendices, and forms will be posted and maintained through **SmartBidNet**. SENATE BILL (SB) 854 REQUIREMENTS: Effective July 1, 2014, no general contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal or awarded a contract for a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) pursuant to Labor Code §1725.5 with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code §1771.1(a). This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR. Refer to the following DIR Website for further information: dir.ca.gov/Public-Works/PublicWorks.html.

PREVAILING WAGES: Prevailing wage requirements apply to all public works projects and must be followed per Article 17 of the General Conditions of the Request for Proposals. The applicable prevailing wage determination during construction is the one in effect on the date the **GMP** is first published in a newspaper of general circulation. Here, the applicable prevailing wage determination for construction services referenced in the published **GMP** advertisement is 2022-2. The **first** bid advertisement date for each District defined GMP phase shall establish the applicable prevailing wage determination, regardless of how many times the Prime Contractor published an advertisement. That first bid advertisement to subcontractors shall state the applicable prevailing wage determination for construction services for the duration of that District defined GMP phase. Each District defined GMP phase for construction services may have a different prevailing wage determination based on its separate publication of the **first** bid advertisement date. DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PARTICIPATION PROGRAM: Pursuant to resolution in support of Service Disabled Veterans Owned Businesses (SDVOB) and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises (DVBE) approved on May 10, 2011 by the Board of Education, Soltek Pacific Construction is required to satisfy a minimum DVBE participation percentage of at least three percent (3%) for this project. In compliance with this program, the bidder shall satisfy all requirements enumerated in the bid package. **GOALS FOR EBE & DVBE PARTICIPATION:** 50% EBE / 5% DVBE.

SUBCONTRACTOR DISTRICT PREQUALIFICATION: Prequalifications are due to the District by March 3, 2023. Every subcontractor to the Contractor seeking to perform work on this bid, regardless of trade, tier, or value of the work, is required to be prequalified with the District. Bids will not be accepted from non-prequalified subcontractors. Visit sandiegounified.org/contractor-prequalification or email prequal@sandi.net for more information.

MEP (Mechanical/Electrical/Plumbing): Subcontractors performing work under one or more of the following license classifications, including any contractor holding A or B licenses and/or performing work of C-4, C-7, C-10, C-16, C-20, C-34, C-36, C-38, C-42, C-43 and C-46, should submit their

prequalification application on PlanetBids. Go to tinyurl.com/SDUSD-PlanetBids, login as a vendor, then click the menu on the left, and select prequalification to get started. MEP prequalifications must be renewed annually on the approval anniversary. **NON-MEP:** Each Non-MEP contractor should submit a Non-MEP subcontractor prequalification application at sandiegounified.org/non-mep. Non-MEP prequalifications must be renewed annually every February.

SOLTEK PACIFIC CONSTRUCTION'S PREQUALIFICATION: Contractors will need to be prequalified with the District in addition to the general contractor's prequalification requirements.

- Prequalification's for the District are due prior to March 3, 2023 at 2:00PM.
- Prequalification's for Soltek Pacific are due prior to March 10, 2023 at 2:00PM.

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE BONDS: As applies per Contract Documents.

BID PACKAGES: This/These project/s is/are being bid as "Bid Packages" per contract number. The bidder must self-perform a minimum of 15% of each bid package that is being bid. If a bidder interested in bidding multiple bid packages, the bidder must submit individual bids for each bid package per GMP. Bidders may demonstrate economy of scale savings on their proposal forms by bidding multiple bid packages for a single GMP. However, bidders may NOT combine multiple bid packages for multiple GMPs, into a single GMP submission. All bids will be reviewed and evaluated for completeness of scope coverage. Subcontracts shall be awarded, if awarded at all, by the general contractor on the basis of lowest bid. The District defines lowest bid as the lowest responsive, responsible bid for a single bid package or the summation of the lowest value of multiple bid packages, if multiple bid packages were proposed by a subcontractor. If DVBE mandatory participation is needed, the next lowest subcontractor who can meet the minimum 3% DVBE requirement may be selected.

BID PACKAGES ARE AS FOLLOWS. It is required that bidders possess any of the following classification(s) of California State Contractors License(s) (or other appropriate license, subject to District approval), valid and in good standing, at the time of bid opening and contract award.

Note: Authorized under Education Code §17406, LLB is a common delivery method used by approximately 89 school districts in California, including 15 school districts within San Diego County. Effective January 1, 2017, Lease-Leaseback is to be used via a competitive selection process for best value award (in contrast to the regular design-bid-build, which requires award to the lowest bidder).
