## Describe the Work You Will Perform on this Project (100 words or less)

Remove and dispose of existing hazardous materials per sample results prepared by *JMR* Environmental Services, Inc. dated May 22, 2014 + report prepared by *SDUSD Physical Plant* Operations. Upon completion of abatement operations, we will remove items per drawings by *Mele Amantea Architects*, *LLP* dated 03/27/2015: roofing material, roof drains and vents, flashing, stucco soffits - vents - framing, return air registers, ductwork, plywood sheathing to expose wood framing, diamond crickets over one roof system - 4-ply - cap sheet and membrane, etc. at *Buildings 100*, 200, 300, and 400.

Saw and remove existing asphalt site paving for new classrooms approx. 10,000 SF; 6" concrete pad approx. 320 SF; clear and grub per *Keynote 2* on **C-101** approx. 3,300 SF; PVC storm drain per *A-002* as necessary for new installations approx. 180' LF.

## Equipment to Be Utilized in Performing Work on this Project

Roofing Demolition: HEPA vacuum, decontamination showers, amended water, 4 mm plastic, pick-axes, heavy bars, rakes, sawzalls, scissor lifts, fork/boom lifts, boxes, etc.

Exterior Site Demolition: 330 Excavator/966 Loader w/attachments, bobcat, trucks, etc.



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### Referrals and Jurisdictional Assignments

Referral procedures will be in accordance with **Article 3 of the SDUSD PSA**. Unions should have such referral procedures posted at their hiring halls.

Subcontractors make work assignments in accordance with Articles 8 & 9, and Addendum 1 of the SDUSD PSA.

- 1. Preliminary assignments by the subcontractor.
- 2. Any craft in disagreement with preliminary assignments must submit written documentation justifying their claim to the work within 14 days after the Pre-job Conference
- 3. The subcontractor shall review each claim and shall make final work assignments.
- 4. Any craft in disagreement with the final assignments may file a jurisdictional dispute consistent with Article 8 of the SDUSD PSA.
