AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between the SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, a California Public School District hereinafter "District" and "Contractor".

WITNESSETH, that the District and the Contractor in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein agree as follows:

1. The Work. Within the Contract Time and for the Contract Price, subject to adjustments thereto pursuant to the Contract Documents, the Contractor shall perform and provide all necessary labor, materials, tools, equipment, utilities, services and transportation to complete in a workmanlike manner all of the Work required in connection with the work of improvement commonly referred to as

REMOVAL OR DEMOLITION OF PORTABLE BUILDINGS ON AN AS-NEEDED BASIS (IDIQ)

Contractor shall complete all Work covered by the Contract Documents, including without limitation, the Drawings and Specifications prepared by the District Representative and other Contract Documents enumerated in Article 6 below, along with all modifications and addenda thereto issued in accordance with the Contract Documents.

- 2. Contract Term. The term of this Agreement shall be from NOVEMBER 1, 2014 through OCTOBER 31, 2015, and any authorized renewal terms. All indemnification provisions contained in the Agreement shall survive beyond the expiration of the Agreement and any renewal terms. This Agreement shall not expire until all work under NTP's issued is completed, accepted, and paid for by District. All indemnification provisions contained in the Agreement shall survive beyond the expiration of this Agreement.
- **3. Compensation.** Contractor shall be compensated for the performance of its obligations under this Agreement as specified in the executed Bid Proposal, for Items *1 through 16*:

Total Not To Exceed Contract Price: \$2,100,000 annually

The District's payment of the Contract Price shall be in accordance with the Contract Documents.

- 4. Liquidated Damages. In the event of the failure or refusal of the Contractor to achieve Substantial Completion of the Work of the Contract Documents within the Contract Time, as adjusted, the Contractor shall be subject to assessment of Liquidated Damages in accordance with the Contract Documents.
- **Termination.** This Agreement may be terminated by the District upon thirty (30) days written notice to Contractor. The District's right to terminate under this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights reserved to the District under this Contract.
- **6. The Contract Documents.** The documents forming a part of the Contract Documents consist of the following, all of which are component parts of the Contract Documents, and any other documents signed by both parties relating to the subject matter of the Agreement, all of which are incorporated by reference as though set forth in full herein.
