The District anticipates awarding to the selected Contractor(s) an agreement with an initial one-year term for an initial total not-to-exceed amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000). The Agreement will have the option to increase the initial term for up to two (2) additional 1-year periods. The guaranteed minimum contract value is Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000).

This is a PSA project and requires prequalification. The District requires that Bidders possess any of the following classification(s) of California State Contractors License(s), valid and in good standing, at the time of bid opening and contract award: **C-15 or other appropriate license, subject to District approval**.

CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: Each bid shall be in accordance with all terms, conditions, plans, specifications and any other documents that comprise the bid package. **The Bid and Contract Documents may be downloaded free of charge at the** *new* **District's online Planroom at** <u>sandiegousdplans.com</u> (click on Public Jobs to view all current bids). PRE-QUALIFICATION OF BIDDERS: Pursuant to Public Contract Code (PCC) for Job Order Contracting for School Districts §20919.24, each contractor wishing to bid as a JOC prime contractor to the District must be prequalified in order to bid. Prequalification application is attached to the solicitation for a JOC contract and will be available as Attachment 14 of the bid package on the first date of advertisement. Completed applications must be submitted to the District no later than (October 13, 2022), which is 10 business days before the bid opening due date. Any questionnaires submitted later than this deadline will not be processed for this Invitation for Bids. The District encourages all JOC Prime Contractors to complete and submit application as soon as possible.

SENATE BILL (SB) 854 REQUIREMENTS: Effective July 1, 2014, no contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal, or awarded a contract for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) pursuant to Labor Code §1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code §1771.1(a)].
