Alright, good morning everybody.

Thanks for making it out to today's pre job conference.

Today's pre job conference is for full 10K through eight school whole site modernization.

I'll start off with some introductions.

Edwin Lebel, the PSA specialist assigned to this project, so.

I'll be your first point of contact. Any sort of questions for regarding this.

This project may sort of A/C matters.

We also have some of the other a staff on the call.

Let me take a look who's here.

We have Maria Cruz.

She's going to be taking notes for us. Todd Etheridge will be monitoring the chat for any sort of mic issues, any sort of questions or comments. And let me see later of our PSA team is director George Harris.

He's on this meeting as well, and our GC team is Soletec Pacific, and Jacqueline is going to be speaking on behalf.

Of soltech.

So I'll go over some sort of team procedures here for this meeting. First of all, the this meeting, it's been recorded and later on we're going to upload a a copy of the meeting to the PSA cloud.

All the participants are there being captured automatically, and you're going to notice yourself muted.

So if you didn't want to, it's time to unmute yourself and say, call upon you to speak.

You can go ahead and raise your hand.

I'll give you the ability to meet your microphone, either myself or George will.

And then you just go ahead and meet your mic.

And then introduce yourself. What organization?

What contractor you are?

Your name and then go ahead and just go and speak what you have to, whether it's reviewing your pre job form or if you have a question or comment if there are any sort of a microphone issues at all, you can't use your microphone. Go ahead and note.

That in the chat and like I said, Todd is going to be monitoring the chat for those sort of things like that.

A couple things I want to go over PSA items.

So today's meeting.

Under Section 8.5 of the PSA purpose of today's meeting is we're gonna review the scope, schedule and work rules and also the work assignments for this project.

Goal for today is that when we're done with this meeting that after all these work assignments have been reviewed and they're made that they're permanent and they're final.

So after today, there's only two ways that the assignments can be changed.

One is if the disputing parties can come to resolution and decide on that, and the other is if they cannot, they will.

There's a process outside of the PSA where the disputing parties wouldn't meet with an arbitrator.

Who will decide that changes for them?

Some information I want to give to contractors who are not signatory to Union, so if you are not signatory to Union and you need, you need to use more than one manpower, you are going to have to utilize the Union hiring hall and I will give an example.

How that goes?

So if you need a crew size of six or more and you're not signatory to union positions, 1/3 and five would be your core workers and positions 24 and six to be manpower.

Dispatch from Union hall.

And any manpower beyond six does need to be dispatched from the Union hall. And please keep in mind to make sure to register your coworkers within Union Hall.

That you make your work assignment to.

So even if you have a coworker who's made multiple, you know you made multiple work assignments and they're covering different trades.

Make sure to register that coworker with each of those those units, and I would say that that is about it for me.

I wanted to see if George, if you wanted to add anything before we move it along.

What they have on the pre job form and it's just say it's a subcontractor is here and they have a tiered contract and a tier contractor is not here.

Hopefully the subcontractor can speak for the tiered contractor, so I will go ahead and pass that along to you then Jack. Jackie.

So as far as a brief description of the project, this is Fulton K8 school, whole site modernization and photovoltaic construction service lease leaseback. Whole site modernization includes modernization work throughout the campus and limited new construction. Site improvements include accessible path of travel.

To get us that that, that single point of entry.

Go there.

Upgrades to new trash enclosure, new fencing, new enclosed bike rack, A/C improvements, and three new shade structures.

Our site work will include miscellaneous storm water, sewer and water upgrades, all building interior space and exterior facades will have improvements with exception

of building 5B.

All restrooms will be upgraded to meet accessibility codes and provide new fixtures and finishes.

All lighting will be replaced with LED lighting. The existing library Building 6 will be converted to our new front office and provide a secure single point of entry. The existing library will be relocated to building 7 for vestibule and outdoor learning. Area will be added and new fold.

Take canopies will be added in the southwest side of the site.

That's the general project description.

And then did you want me to go over what we plan on self performing here as well?






