Interim housing and increment one GMP one with sunk construction. So I'd like to start off by letting everyone know that this meeting is being recorded and a copy of the recording will be uploaded under this project on the cloud site. I ask that you please use the chat feature to check in by letting everyone know who you are, what company or union you're with, a means of getting a hold of you, whether it be an e-mail or phone number, and then request that all questions be asked under.

The chat as well for easier tracking.

As we start this meeting, everyone is muted. So if you try and unmute yourself, you won't be able to. If you have a comment question or would like to read if you're a sub, you need to go ahead and raise your hand and be recognized once recognized we.

Will enable your your mic once your mic is enabled, we will ask you to unmute yourself on your side.

So when speaking, please be assured to identify what company or union you're with. Who you are and who you're directing the question to.

Or the comment. So whether it be to the sub that we're currently reviewing or to the GC directly if you don't have a microphone or encounter any glitches, please use the chat feature to communicate with the group to help save time.

We always ask that, if possible, if our Union reps can accept the assignments in the chat. Also noting the subname.

With that acceptance, we understand that for recording purposes, having it verbalized.

ls important.

So I will be reading any acceptances from the chat just to make sure.

Verbalized on the recording. If there are no hands or comments or challenges, or no acceptances in the chat, it's understood that the assignment is accepted final and will be noted as no comment, no issue in the meeting minutes along with the recording, the chat log in the meeting.

Minutes will be uploaded to the cloud as well, so I am Maria Cruz.

I am the primary contact for the day-to-day questions regarding the PSA participation on this project.

Also on our call is our fantastic PSA team and of course.

Course are ever optimistic and sensible leader director George Harris, who gets involved when any substantial matters or issues arise.

We also want to welcome to today's meeting Andrew Sullivan, our PM in Suleen, our PA for the GC sunt construction.

Next, we're going to review the significance of a pre job conference.

So the first thing, of course, is that it's a mandatory meeting under section 8.5 of the PSA, which states in short.

To avoid jurisdictional disputes, a pre job conference is required to be held.

Prior to the start of work by all contractors at every level performing work covered by this agreement for the purpose of reviewing scopes of work and determining crafts to be used, establishing estimated manpower needs.

Getting idea of the work schedule for the contract and of course the project working roles. Now our Article 16 goes into further detail describing the activities to take place at the pre job conference.

Just noting that all work assignments should be disclosed by each contractor.

And if there's any kind of formal jurisdictional dispute between unions on a work assignment that may pop up during the meeting, they will be noted.

And then I'm gonna review how those are handled shortly.

Additionally, the purpose of the pre job conference is to bring together the district, the GC, the subcontractors and the Union to ensure everyone is on the same page with the scopes, schedules and manpower needs.

Let me see also.

Additionally, it is to again ensure that all scopes have been reviewed, and if there is a dispute, it is noted prior to the start of work.

And my screen just froze up.

Ed or George, is my screen still moving for you guys?

My system just froze up over here.

So it must just be that, OK.

So with that, I will go into the jurisdictional disputes usually are handled a couple different ways.

So if during the course of the meeting a challenge has happened where we will first of course ask if the Union is present, who is being being assigned the work, and if they accept the work, then we're. If the Union is absent, we will note the challenge and.

Add it to the meeting minutes.

And let the contractor know if the contractor is absent, we will note the challenge. Let the GC know GC won't let the contractor know.

And we will go from there.

Additionally.

After that, our PSA implements what is called a composite crew, which means for our non signatory contractors. If you have a crew of two or more, you will need to utilize the Union hiring call to meet the ratio.

So the ratios for the PSI.

Excuse me for the PSA are A1 to 1, so one coworker for non union contractors to one dispatched union worker.

So if you have a crew of let's say 7.

The first, third and 5th workers can be your Union or your non union core workers with the 2nd, 4th and 6th worker being the Union Dispatch. Now all workers after six. So that 7th worker would still be.

Union dispatch.

Much as its three core workers per trade.

So when requesting dispatch from the Union hiring home, a contractor can and should stipulate any specific any specific skills needed to complete the task,

especially if it's any kind of specialty requirements. I always like to use the example of asbestos. They have to have a certain certificate and.

California electricians have to be licensed, so if you need anything specific, we always recommend that you add that on the dispatch.

Depending on the Union, the contractor can request workers by name, and of course can request workers by the the districts identified priority ZIP code list so that gives 100% San Diego County with 70% district boundaries and 35% district targeted ZIP code which have.

Been identified in the paperwork that's been given out to GCS and Subs.

At today's meeting, each contractor will be asked to make a work assignment.

Each sub, including peer Subs, are responsible for making their own work

assignments and cannot make a work assignment for anybody else.

So a GC cannot make a work assignment for sub.

A sub cannot work.

Make a work assignment for each year, also noting that Wallon or PSA projects all fringe benefits are required to be paid to the assigned or associated trade unions. Trust as selected.

All Subs to be reviewed today will have already completed a pre job form describing their scope of work.

And assignments. The contractor has the right to choose the assignment of scope as long as the Union being assigned claims and accepts it. Once the scope of work is assigned to a craft and or union, it is considered final and can only be changed one of two ways.

The 1st way is the two unions discuss it usually right here in the meeting and agree that it does need to be changed or at the discretion of an arbitrator through a process that is outside of this meeting.

Changes other than work assignments, such as scope of work, clarifications do need to be reflected in the pre job form and will need to be revised and resubmitted right away.

All right, so now let's get into how this meeting will go.

Andrew will describe the overall project and scope, noting of plans on self performing. We have about 16 or we do have 16 complete forms to review this morning. I will pull up the subcontractor paperwork announcing them 1 by 1. If the sub is here, they will raise their hand and be recognized. I'm going to enable their mic at that point and then ask them to unmute themselves.

Each sub will then describe the scope of work that they're performing.

Announce their work assignments.

Identify any tier Subs and then answer any questions from unions.

Now if the sub is not present, Andrew will go ahead and read the scope and assignment and answer any questions and take notes of questions that he can't answer.

And then we'll get the response from that sub leader and blast it out to all the units. Now, if a Union challenges the work we already described, we're going to check to see if the Union assigned is here.

We're going to note it on the meeting minutes and then we'll mark it on the assignment as challenged.

We do always like to remind the contractors that the work assignment is 100% up to them as long as the Union they're assigning it to does accept the work.

Now work assignments will not be changed.

Unless described.

Two unions agree.

Arbitrator orders it OK.

So George, is there anything you'd like to add?

So as contract summaries, Hardy elementary interim housing and Increment 1 project is a lease leaseback for GMP, one construction at Hardy Elementary School includes installation of interim housing with seven kindergarten classroom trailers for transitional kindergarten trailers with restrooms and a portable restroom facility. The interim set up also.

Features a new playground, fire access lane, perimeter fencing. Increment 1 includes construction.

Of a new 3000 square foot kitchen and 3000 square foot lunch shelter to support daily food service operations.

A new E parking lot with 31 stalls and an engineered shoring wall.

Campus upgrades include a new asphalt playground with modern play structures, basketball court and Wall Wall Court.

Site wide infrastructure improvements including storm drain sewer water lines, upgraded site lighting, Cox and AT&T.

The service installations at CMU trash enclosure and comprehensive landscaping throughout the renovated areas.
