PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The whole site modernization of the Keiller Leadership Academy Charter School consist of construction of a new two-story elementary classroom building, three kindergarten classrooms, site and play area improvements, and remodel of the existing Multipurpose Building and Food Service facilities.

SENATE BILL (SB) 854 REQUIREMENTS: Effective July 1st, 2014, no general contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal or awarded a contract for a public works project (awarded on or after April 1st, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) pursuant to Labor Code §1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code §1771.1(a)]. PREVAILING WAGES: Prevailing wage requirements apply to all public works projects and must be followed per Article 17 of the General Conditions of this bid. All subcontractors shall pay all workers on the project not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to sections §1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code. Bidders and Bidders' subcontractors shall comply with the registration and qualification requirements pursuant to sections §1725.5 and §1771.1 of the California Labor Code.

DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PARTICIPATION PROGRAM: Pursuant to resolution in support of Service Disabled Veterans Owned Businesses (SDVOB) and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises (DVBE) approved on May 10th, 2011 by the Board of Education, SOLPAC Pacific Construction is required to satisfy a minimum DVBE participation percentage of at least three percent (3%) for this project. A bidder interested in bidding multiple bid packages must also submit individual bids for each bid package and then provide bids with multiple bid packages combined. Example, if a bidder is interested in bidding Bid Package 1 Survey AND Bid Package 6 Earthwork, Import, Export, SWPPP, Demo Site & Existing Portables combined (for a lower bid overall price than if each package were submitted separately), then the bidder would submit one bid form noting both bid package numbers and the combined amount on the bid form document. Note, the bidder MUST still submit a bid for each package individually in addition to the combined bid. *The general contractor reserves the right to award bid packages as a combination or as a single package. Subcontracts shall be awarded, if awarded at all, by general contractor on a best value basis.* Bids will be reviewed and evaluated for completeness of scope coverage and awarded to the subcontractor who is deemed to be the best value for the project as a whole.
