This is a LEASE-LEASEBACK project and will be awarded on a best value basis. Bids will be evaluated and trued up for completeness of scope coverage and awarded to the subcontractor who is deemed to be the Best Value subcontractor for the project as a whole.

This project estimate is between \$100 million and \$120 million and consists of a new administration building, a new 2-story classroom building, a new gym, a new child development center, modernizations of existing stage, modernization of two buildings to create a kitchen and laboratory classrooms, a new football field and site improvements. Construction will take place from August 2020 through the July of 2022.

<u>DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PARTICIPATION PROGRAM</u>: Pursuant to Resolution In Support of Service Disabled Veterans Owned Businesses (SDVOB) and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises (DVBE) approved on May 10, 2011 by the Board of Education, the Balfour Beatty is required to satisfy a minimum DVBE participation percentage of at least three percent (3%) for this project. In compliance with this Program, bidders will be expected to account for DVBE participation in their bid.

PREQUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: Contractors will need to be pre-qualified with the District in addition to Balfour Beatty's pre-qualification requirements.

In addition, every subcontractor to the Contractor seeking to perform work valued at more than one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) of the value of the Contract is required to meet the minimum criteria as outlined herein. Each non-MEP subcontractor shall complete the "NON-MEP SUBCONTRACTOR'S PREQUALIFICATION FORM". In addition, all prequalification applications must be submitted to the District no later than 2 weeks prior to bid day. PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE BONDS: All Bids that exceed \$100,000 will require a payment and performance bond in the amount of 100% of the bid amount or subcontract amount, from a California Admitted Surety acceptable to Balfour Beatty Construction and not less than AM Best A- or better rating. The cost of the Payment & Performance Bond must be included within the bid amount and at no additional cost. A letter from sub-contractor's surety stating sub-contractor's ability to bond for entire value of bid must be included with bid. All Bids that are less than \$100,000 will require an executed Personal Guarantee. If a Bidder cannot provide an executed Personal Guarantee, Bidder must include the cost of the Payment & Performance Bond within the Bid Amount and at no additional cost._See specifications for individual Owner requirements and Liability Insurance (and not less than AM best A- or better rating). All subcontractors are required to sign the Subcontractor Agreement (Document 05500) which references the AGC Subcontract Terms and Conditions (Document 00500) and provide Waiver of Subrogation.

Balfour Beatty Construction Safety, Health and Environmental (SHE): All project foremen, project managers, and /or superintendents that are onsite or supervising sub-contractor crews will be required to take the Balfour Beatty Construction ZERO HARM SAFETY Training Class prior to start of construction. This is a 2 hour class that will be held at either the Balfour Beatty Construction Southwest corporate office or at the project site throughout the course of the project. The cost for the class is FREE of Charge; time allotment for attendance must be included in sub-contractor's bid/schedule.
