Thank you.

Good morning, everyone.

My name is Ivory Anderson.

I am the PSA specialist assigned to this project.

Today's pre pre job conference meeting is a required meeting pursuant to the PSA Section 8.5 and 16.1 which states that the general contractors required to have a pre job conference meeting with the unions before they can start work.

Today's meeting is the one of the antenna of today's meeting.

Is discuss the overall scope of work and a selected number of subcontractors that have to start within the next week or so.

They'll be a.

They'll be a session two meeting later on this this later on today's meeting is recorded.

We ask that you utilize if you, when it becomes your turn to speak or you want to add something, we ask that you raise your hand and ask to be unmuted.

We asked that you identify yourself.

In the chat.

If possible.

Put your responses in the chat, whether it's accepting a work assignment or questions about work assignment.

We're by that response would be memorialized that we can go back later on. Again, today's meeting is.

Is being recorded and will be uploaded to the cloud a couple things. Couple reminders about the PSA that all contractors must sign a letter of assent and submit and submit a work assignment before they can start work, as well as have a pre job conference meeting.

On non union contractors you have to have your core employees referred back to

the project.

With through the affected Union that you're working with.

Reminders San Diego Unified School District has a local hire goal.

That goal is that 100% of the workforce lives somewhere in the county of San Diego. 70% live in the school district, ZIP code and 35% live in the 11 targeted ZIP code ZIP code.

How the contractors help us effectuate that goal, not only by having employees that live in in the county, but when they make the request for dispatch.

Along with the skill set certification needed out of that Union member.

You might want to ask if they have anyone available that lives in the school district.

Zip code school Dist school that you're working at. Zip code.

For work to non union contractors would work to require.

More than one worker at at at the same time or the operation of more than one piece of equipment at one time, you're likely to have a composite crew.

An example of a composite crew is if you had a scope of work that required 6 employees, three would be your core employees and three would be dispatched from the affected Union.

So positions 1/3 and five would belong to the contractor.

Were 246 and beyond.

Would belong to the affected union all as a reminder, a timely request for dispatch is is.

The go to submitter, your core worker form or request for dispatch at least 48 hours before the start of work.

Less weekends and holidays.

A reminder, no contractor or their workers are required to join a union to perform under the PSA.

They simply have to follow the guidelines of the PSA and the Master Labor Agreement or schedule A that they're working under.

Lastly, a reminder, the prevailing wages that are due the workers, you'll pay the base rate on the workers. Check where the fringe benefits component will be paid on the workers check at a later time.

Before I hand it off to Belfer Beatty to talk about the overall scope of work and then go through the individual sub, I wanted to give Director Harris an opportunity. To add, add to the conversation.

What I did forget to mention is our hopes is that the affected contractors are on the call today and can speak to their scope of work if they're not on the call. If there's not a representative from the company on the call.

Then Balfour Beatty will speak to that scope of work on behalf of the contractor. So go ahead, Belfer, Betty.

Separate contract. So we have 4 phases. The first phase we're removing and abating the existing portables on campus and then we'll be constructing a new classroom building.

And then the phase two will be modernizing building 205 hundred 600 while doing the solar portion of the work and very minor fire alarm. Yeah, great.

And then phase three will be modernizing building 304 hundred, 809 hundred and demolishing an existing building 700.

And then the last phase, phase four will be constructing a new joint use field that will be.

Turf. Yeah. Whoops irrigation.

And it's a city, yeah, with joint use. So with the city as well.

And then we do have some offsite work as DG.

Yeah, and water service minor SCG and E and water service work that will be also occurring on this job.

There was a confusion on words when when we started putting together these projects.

Miata kept referring to all three projects as if they were in the same phase where I kept saying no. No, they're completely separate.

There's the whole site, there's the joint use and there's the solar project.

But it almost seemed like that when you mentioned phase four.

As if it's they're all in one.

But these are three separate projects started at different times correctly. Or are they going on simultaneous, potentially simultaneously?

Potentially simultaneously, the solar will be done while we're doing whole site work as well.

And finishes in the building 100. Yeah, and then finishes in building 100. But the joint use field.

Will probably be separate, separate from the rest of the phases.

It's its own phase, phase four, but again we probably will be doing minor change order work and.

Finishing up any buildings that hadn't been completed.

You are correct with the three different contracts and starting at 3 different times.

But we're gonna, there'll be a little bit of overlap period like with landscaping possibly and some finishes in the buildings, so forth.


