This is a mandatory meeting section 8.5 and 16.1 of the PSA.

The purpose of this meeting is to bring together the GC subcontractors and the unions provide overview, scope, schedule and rules of the project.

Gcs and subcontractors can announce the scope, craft, and manpower needed that you can just have the opportunity to ask any questions to clarify the scope and assignments.

Our goal is by the end of this meeting to have every work assignment permitted. Every subcontractor, including tiered sub, must be identified upon sign a contract. Every sub must sign and submit a letter of assent to our office before starting work. When it comes to a composite crew, if a contractor is not signatory to the Union and the work requires a crew or two or more, then you must utilize the Union Hall for manpower.

Co workers are allowed to work on the project, they just must go to the applicable union to register.

Just give you a quick overview of a workforce 6 or more workers. 1/3 and five will be

your core workers. 246 and on will be your Union workers.

When hiring workforce, the district has goals for residents of San Diego County and targeted ZIP code.

Each sub, including tiered Subs, are responsible for making their own work assignment. Gcs can't make a work assignment for a sub, and a sub can't make a work assignment for a tiered sub. Once the scope work is assigned to the craft in Union, its final can only be.

Changed in two ways.

The 1st way would be if the two unions are. I mean, two unions involved must agree to the change, the 2nd includes the direction of arbitrator, which is a separate process outside of the PSA.

What we'll do at this moment, we'll go ahead and.

Go over all the work assignments. I'll turn it over to Staten Solar.

Have them give us a brief overview of the the project.

I mean the contract and we'll go ahead and have them.

Let us know if they're going to be self performing any work.

If so, we'll have them outline the scope and the Union that they're going to utilize. And after that, we'll what we'll do is we'll go one by one, each sub. We just ask that once you once we call your sub out.

Your company.

Then if you can, please raise your hand if you're here, and then we'll go ahead and unmute you and have you speak to your scope of work and also the Union that you're gonna utilize.

And then we have some tree removal, but I haven't got a tree.
