You know company you're with and then if that's the problem, then will the the GCD. If you'll go ahead and speak for your school work.

If you are like a subcontractor, I'm next.

I'm going to go over some PST items, so the purpose of today's meeting is we're going to go over the scope, schedule and work rules for this project.

Overall, we just want to make sure that everybody involved the contractors, the Union rips, PSA team, everybody is on the same page before the actual work starts. So after today.

Umm well, you know for the goals for this meeting.

Is that all the work assignments have been made and that they're finals? So after today the work assignments, if they're going to be changed, they're gonna be changed two ways.

One is if the disputing parties can come to an agreement and then they make that change, and if not, the disputing parties will go before an opportunity to will make the change for them afterwards.

The modifications to the Simon student team made in writing, so for Subs who are not signatory to a union and you do need to utilize more than one manpower, you will have to use the Union hiring hall for manpower being dispatched to you.

So I'll give you an example how that works.

So say you wanted a cruise size of six, you would have to have your first four worker on site.

Who is registered?

Of course, with the Union hall and then the second worker would be dispatched Union Hall third would be a core worker, 4th would be a dispatchment Union hall, 5th would be your core worker and 6th would be dispatch.

The Union hall, any manpower beyond six, what have to be dispatched from the Union hall.

So please make sure that all of your coworkers and are registered with the Union hall of their craft.

So even if you're core worker uh has been made, you know, multiple assignments. Say your coworker is is gonna do multiple trades and on your pre job form you've made multiple work assignments to different unions.

If it's that one core worker, they're gonna have to register with each of those union halls of that craft, so make sure you get that done before you actually have them on site.
