Spreckels Elementary School Whole Site Modernization and Joint Use Improvements (Lease-Leaseback)
On behalf of the San Diego Unified School District

Project estimate is between \$50 million and \$54 million.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The anticipated schedule of the whole site modernization is October 2021 thru August 2024. The project consists of a renovation of four existing classroom buildings, renovation of multipurpose building, with new stage, common spaces and a kitchen. Renovation of educational service (Admin) Building, including accessibility upgrades, offices and staff lounge. New construction of one new two-story classroom building, new expanded parking lot with new two-lane pick-up/drop-off with pedestrian safety measures. Joint use improvements, including natural turf field, DG track, parking lot expansion, and playground/hardcourt area. Removal and replacement of existing concrete walkways and AC paving and landscape improvements.

PREVAILING WAGES: Prevailing wage requirements apply to all public works projects and must be followed per Article 17 of the General Conditions of this bid. The applicable wage determination for this contract is 2021-1, and will be 2021-1 for the duration of the contract. This includes amendments, change orders, and warranty work relating to this contract number. DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PARTICIPATION PROGRAM: Pursuant to Resolution in support of Service Disabled Veterans Owned Businesses (SDVOB) and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises (DVBE) approved on May 10, 2011 by the Board of Education, Balfour Beatty is required to satisfy a minimum DVBE participation percentage of at least three percent (3%) for this project. In compliance with this program, bidders shall satisfy all requirements enumerated in this bid package. **GOAL FOR EBE & DVBE PARTICIPATION:** 50% EBE / 6% DVBE.

PREQUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: Contractors will need to be pre-qualified with the District in addition to Balfour Beatty's pre-qualification requirements.

DISTRICT PREQUALIFICATION: Subcontractor's Prequalification (Non-MEP and MEP): If components of the Project will be performed by mechanical, electrical, or plumbing ("MEP") subcontractors regardless of value of their work, then each of those MEP subcontractors with the following license classifications that intend to propose as a subcontractor performing work under one or more of the following license classifications, is required to have been prequalified by the District: C-4, C-7, C-10, C-16, C-20, C-34, C-36, C-38, C-42, C-43, and/or C-46. Every MEP subcontractor performing in the respective trade must be prequalified by submitting the "MEP SUBCONTRACTOR'S PREQUALIFICATION APPLICATION" to the district. In addition, every subcontractor to the Contractor seeking to perform work valued at more than one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) of the value of the Contract is required to meet the minimum criteria as outlined herein. Each non-MEP subcontractor shall complete the "NON-MEP SUBCONTRACTOR'S PREQUALIFICATION FORM". In addition, all prequalification applications must be submitted to the District no later than 2 weeks prior to bid day. BALFOUR BEATTY PREQUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: Contracts over \$500,000 will need to be pre-qualified. If you haven't done so already, please log onto and complete our pre-qualification form online: https://prequal.balfourbeattyus.com/login.

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE BONDS: All Bids that exceed \$100,000 will require a payment and performance bond in the amount of 100% of the bid amount or subcontract amount, from a California Admitted Surety acceptable to Balfour Beatty Construction and not less than AM Best A- or better rating. The cost of the Payment & Performance Bond must be included within the bid amount and at no additional cost. A letter from sub-contractor's surety stating sub-contractor's ability to bond for entire value of bid must be included with bid. All Bids that are less than \$100,000 will require an executed Personal Guarantee. If a Bidder cannot provide an executed Personal Guarantee, Bidder must include the cost of the Payment & Performance Bond within the Bid Amount and at no additional cost._See specifications for individual Owner requirements and Liability Insurance (and not less than AM best A- or better rating). All subcontractors are required to sign the Subcontractor Agreement (Document 05500) which references the AGC Subcontract Terms and Conditions (Document 00500) and provide Waiver of Subrogation.

Balfour Beatty Construction Safety, Health and Environmental (SHE): All project foremen, project managers, and /or superintendents that are onsite or supervising sub-contractor crews will be required to take the Balfour Beatty Construction ZERO HARM SAFETY Training Class prior to start of construction. This is a 2-hour class that will be held at either the Balfour Beatty Construction Southwest corporate office or at the project site throughout the course of the project. The cost for the class is FREE of Charge; time allotment for attendance must be included in sub-contractor's bid/schedule.

BID PACKAGES: This project is being bid as "Bid Packages". Bidders will have the option to bid multiple bid packages; however the bidder must self-perform a minimum of 15% of each bid package that is being bid. A bidder interested in bidding multiple bid packages must also submit individual bids for each bid package and then provide bids with multiple bid packages combined. Example, if a bidder is interested in bidding the BP 22 Play Field Equipment & Structures AND BP 35 Photovoltaic Systems combined (for a lower bid overall price than if each package were submitted separately), then the bidder would submit one bid form noting both bid package numbers and the combined amount on the bid form document. Note, the bidder MUST still submit a bid for each package individually in addition to the combined bid. The general contractor reserves the right to award bid packages as a combination or as a single package. Subcontracts shall be awarded, if awarded at all, by general contractor on a best value basis. Bids will be reviewed and evaluated for completeness of scope coverage and awarded to the subcontractor who is deemed the best value for the project as a whole.
