① Whole Site Modernization

Clark Middle School is in the heart of the residential neighborhood of City Heights. The school was built in 1997 and has 65 classrooms serving over 1,000 students in this diverse community. The school is involved in an educational pilot program called City Heights Educational Collaborative. With this program, the school receives resources from San Diego State University and Price Charities.

The school is situated on 11 acres with more than half of which is open landscaping, athletic field and joint use park facilities. The approximately 146,000 square feet of facilities include four permanent two-story buildings for classrooms, library, cafeteria, gymnasium, and administration offices, as well as 10 portable classrooms to accommodate the growing student population.

To support student learning, health, safety and security the entire campus at Clark Middle School will undergo a Whole Site Modernization to include:

- New air conditioning and heating system installation in all classrooms and other learning environments
- Accessibility upgrades to existing
 - Restrooms throughout the campus
 - Classrooms and other school facilities throughout the campus
 - Site side-walks, ramps, stairs, hardscapes and other path-of-travel locations throughout the campus
- Installation of new interior building and exterior site surveillance cameras and security lighting
- Upgrading the entire fire alarm system throughout the campus
- Security and access modifications to existing fencing and gates
- Renovation of the existing food serving line space for use as kiosk, and the construction of a new food kiosk building
- Renovation and expansion of the existing lunch court shelter
- Renovation of existing kitchen by adding a new staff restroom and locker room, walk-in freezer, dry storage room, office, refrigeration, hand sinks and heated self-service cases
- Removal of three portable classrooms and two relocatable classrooms
- Upgrading non-code compliant signage throughout the campus
- Upgrade electrical systems
- Repair or replacement of plumbing and deteriorated sewer systems, as needed to upgrade restrooms
- Repair or replacement of roof systems as needed
- Replacement of doors in areas of new work as required
- Repair or replacement of flooring, carpet and tile where displaced during construction
- Upgrade existing basketball playground surface with new paving and markings
- Upgrades to kitchen truck delivery/receiving traffic circulation area with new asphalt surfacing and striping
