Cubberley ES is located in Mission Village, a residential neighborhood within the community of Serra Mesa. The residents in this diverse community are comprised of working class and middle class families that are professionals, military personnel and retired citizens. Most of the average 180 student body are residents of the community. This campus was designed in the popular Mid-Century Modern style of the 1950s and 1960s with all one-story classroom buildings in rectangular shape and large eaves to shelter the walkways. The school also offers extracurricular programs and Primetime Extended Day.

The campus opened in 1959 as a four building school. Currently the 36,219 square feet of learning space consists of 5 permanent and 7 portable buildings. These serve classrooms, administration offices, a multipurpose room, food services and a library, which was built in 2003. In 2019, a new Joint Use Field was constructed with new natural turf replacing a large portion the existing decomposed granite playfield. The new addition will provide a park to the community after school hours and weekends.
