① Joint Use Field

Horton Elementary's campus is situated on a hilltop in the Southeast San Diego community of Chollas View. This neighborhood school serves grades kindergarten through 5th. The student population is culturally diverse as represented by the community. The schools enrollment averages about 450 students. The mission of the teachers and staff is to help students become self-motivated and lifelong learners.

The campus opened in 1958 with three buildings for classrooms, administration offices and a multipurpose room. Over the years portable classroom buildings were added due to the increase of student population. In 2003, a two-story classroom building was constructed that included a library and amphitheater. The total square feet of facilities at this site is approximately 54,000.

This Joint Use Agreement project with the District and City of San Diego involves the construction of a Playfield by the District on the schools existing Decomposed Granite (DG) Field. The agreement allows the Joint Use Field to be used by the students during school hours and open as a public park to the community after school, on weekends and during school breaks.
