La Jolla Elementary School opened in 1896 in the heart of the community in which it was named. The school serves the students in the area and also accepts choice enrollment. They were awarded in 2018 with California Distinguished School for the third year, and in 2016, received national recognition with a National Blue Ribbon School Award for Exemplary High Performing Schools. This is due to their dedicated faculty and staff, as well as parents who contribute greatly.

The campus originally opened in 1896 with four buildings. In 1942, 1948 and again in 1950, a building was added. In 1962, the four original 1896 buildings were demolished and replaced by five buildings. Over the years, 11 portable buildings were added as the student population increased. In 2004, a library building was built in the center of campus. The total square footage of learning space is now 46,156.
