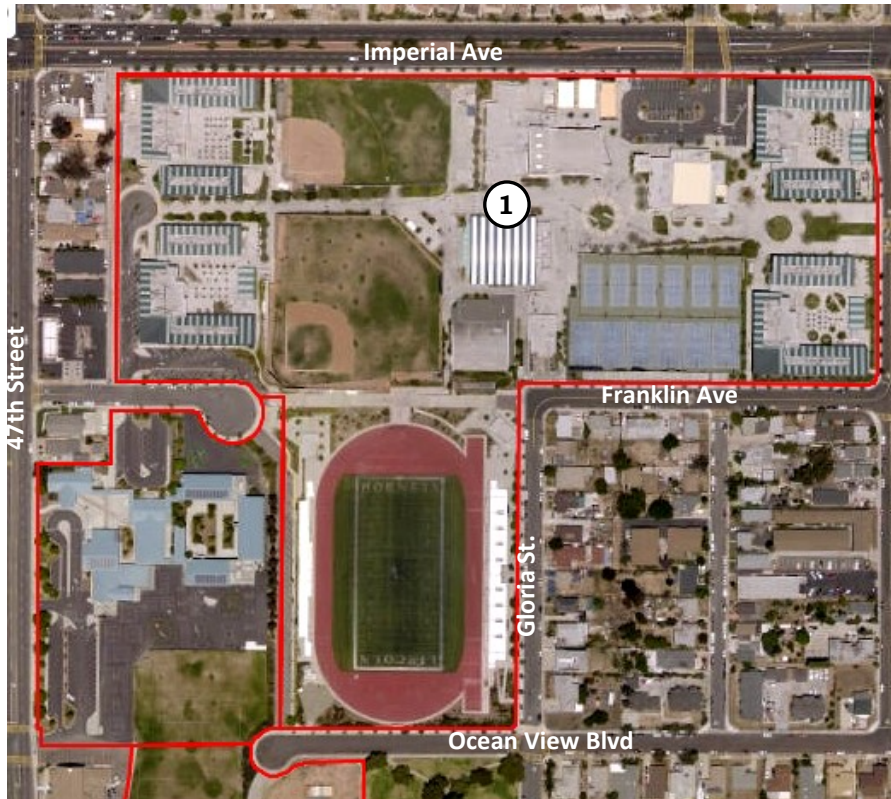

Lincoln High School is located in the residential neighborhood of Lincoln Park and serves the students in the community. This urban school provides STEAM Middle College education, which gives the students the opportunity to take college courses while attending high school. They have four career pathways available for students: social justice, arts, science and engineering, and public safety.

The campus sits on 24.4 acres and was originally built in 1947. The entire campus was rebuilt and reopened in 2007 with a total of 15 permanent buildings that house administration offices with counseling center, 115 classrooms and science, labs, innovation center (library/media), food services with kiosks, performing arts theater, physical education facilities, athletic areas, and a parking garage.



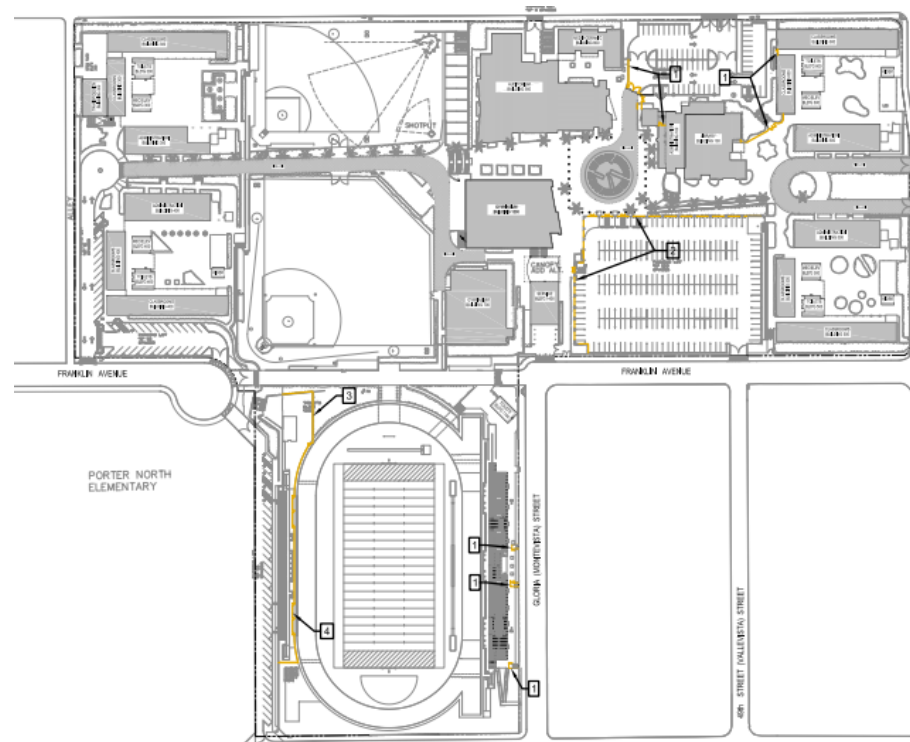

This project will provide a 10 foot high ornamental fence with gates at entry areas, stadium bleachers, and a 10 foot chain link fence around parking garage and at the stadium entrance with gates. In addition, installation of a 3 1/2 foot high fence and gate along the front of the visitors stadium bleachers.
