Marshall Middle School is located in the community of Scripps Ranch and serves the residents in this area. The school originally opened in 1992 at another site, however, they soon realized that more space was needed due to a growing population. A new campus was built in 2007 and opened in 2008 at it's current location. The students and staff are proud of their achievements.

The 26 acre campus has 8 permanent buildings with over 151,000 square feet of facilities. These buildings include administration offices, classrooms and a multipurpose room with food services, performing arts and physical education with locker rooms. The campus also includes sports fields, hard courts and a parking lot.

A Solar Photovoltaic System will be installed at Marshall Middle School. The proposed system for this campus will have solar panels that are mounted on tilt elevated canopies within the existing parking lot. These canopies will provide shade structures and under-mount LED lighting for parking lots. This system will create an energy-efficient and renewable power source. It will deliver a clean energy supply during both the academic year and school vacations.

All elements of installation will include, but not limited to:

- Solar PV modules
- Inverters
- All electrical connectors, cabling and components necessary for a complete solar system
- All mounting systems
