Site-Specific Bond Project List

The following needs were identified through a comprehensive planning process, which included input from school site representatives to cluster meetings, district departments and other assessment measures.

The language below will be included in the bond resolution:

Project Improvements to Support Student Learning and Instruction

- **Provide 21st century technology upgrades, including audiovisual projection capabilities for all students**
- **Enhance fiber optics in classrooms to increase bandwidth, which facilitates multiple concurrent applications**
- **Install a wireless network (WIFI)**
- **Join with the city of San Diego to co-fund joint-use playfields**

School Improvements to Support Student Health, Safety and Security

- **Improve the student drop-off and pick-up areas from vehicles and buses**
- **Provide paved bus drop-off area for the Balboa Park program and improve site circulation**
- **Provide additional covered outdoor dining areas to accommodate student enrollment and special program**
- **Install security lighting, as well as increase vandalism and intrusion safeguards, including modifications to fencing and gates**
- **Provide site safety communication system**
- **Remove or minimize risks of any potentially hazardous material throughout the facility**
- **Renovate food service areas and add food kiosks to increase service efficiency and provide healthier food choices**

Projects to Improve School Accessibility, Code Compliance Upgrades

- **Renovate/reconfigure existing restrooms and locker rooms**
- **Improve accessibility to all classrooms, labs, restrooms and other school facilities to comply with accessibility regulations, including ADA Title I & II**
- **Install grease trap and three-compartment sink in kitchen**
- **Repair/replace/remove old portable classrooms**

Major Building Systems Repair/Replacement

- **Replace aging wiring and upgrade electrical systems, including adding additional receptacles throughout campus**
- **Repair/replace sidewalks and hardscape, including playground areas**
- **Repair/restore building interiors, exteriors, finishes and fixtures, including windows and doors**
- **Repair/replace inefficient heating and ventilation systems**
- **Repair/replace deteriorating plumbing, sewer lines and storm sewer systems as needed**
- **Repair/replace/upgrade performance spaces/multipurpose rooms**

Building Systems Repair and Replacement

- Improve worn or damaged interior and exterior finishes and fixtures
- Repair or replace aging, leaky roofs
- Repair or replace deteriorating plumbing and underground sewer systems
- Repair or upgrade outdated electrical systems, aging wiring and electrical panels
- Replace or repair concrete sidewalks and other exterior infrastructure in poor condition
- Replace or restore old or broken doors and windows
- Replacement of old light fixtures and fluorescent light ballasts
- Resurfacing and grading of decomposed granite playgrounds and fields
- Sand and refinish wood stage, gym and classroom floors

School Improvements to Support Student Learning and Instruction

- Provide up-to-date classroom and instructional technology required for 21st century student learning and teaching
- Upgrade wired and wireless infrastructure and equipment to support technology systems and leverage federal and state matching funds for school technology programs

School Improvements to Support Student Health, Safety and Security

- Provide school site security improvements, including increased lighting, fencing, and vandalism and intrusion safeguards
- Upgrade and install air conditioning for schools located in climate zone 2
- Upgrade and expand student food service areas and kitchens
- Replace obsolete fire alarms and update emergency communications systems

Improve School Accessibility and Code Compliance Upgrades

- Improve accessibility for disabled persons and comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Title 24
- Repair aging portable classrooms to comply with code requirements

Quality Neighborhood Schools

- Improve physical education, athletic facilities and turf fields
