Valencia Park Elementary school is named after it's diverse residential neighborhood where it is located in San Diego. This is a STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics) magnet school serving approximately 450 students each year. With help from grants, the students are taught an interdisciplinary curriculum that encourages thinkers and innovators. The teachers and staff provide the students opportunities to engage in experiences to improve their knowledge of STEAM.

The school was originally built in 1953 as a two building school serving the residents of Valencia Park. Within 15 years (1968), there were three more buildings constructed to accommodate the growth in the area. In 2004, a two-story classroom building was built. With the addition of 16 portable classroom buildings throughout the years, there is now just over 68,000 square feet of learning space on the 17.96 acre campus.
